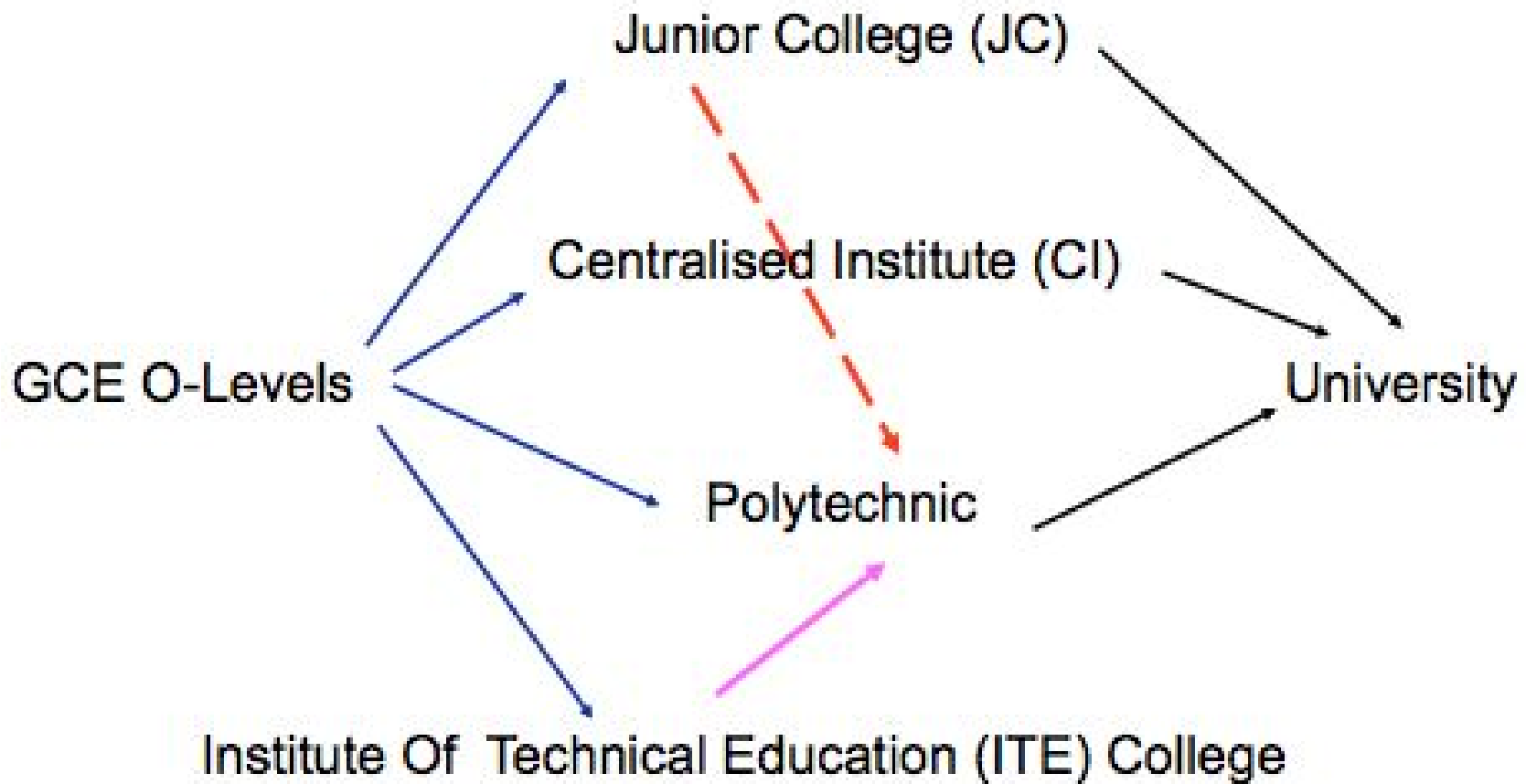

Joint Admission Exercise (JAE)

- One exercise is conducted upon release of GCE O-Level results
- Admission exercise is for admission to JC, MI, Polytechnic & ITE



Points to Note

1. Fill up all 12 options available to you
2. Choose JCs/Poly courses which meet your results
3. Appeals will only be entertained if you meet the JC's/Poly's course cut off point
4. Have 1 or 2 options where your results exceed course cut off point.



Alternative Admission Process

For JC1 and Equivalent Level

- Direct School Admission (DSA–JC)
- For students who demonstrate a more diverse range of achievements and talents in seeking admission at Pre-U level.
- Conducted prior to the annual Joint Admission Exercise (JAE). Students admitted under DSA–JC need not take part in the JAE as long as they meet the criteria for admission for a JC

Entry Requirements to JC

a) at least a D7 for Mother Tongue (MT) [or a pass in CLB/MLB/TLB] AND a Mathematics Subject

b) L1R5 \leq 20 points

- L1 - English
- R1 - A Science or Math Subject
- R2 - A Humanities Subject
- R3 - A Science or Math or Humanities Subject
- R4 & R5 - Any other 2 Best Subjects
- (CCA grades cannot be counted as a subject)

c) Failed to obtain the requisite language and/or Math grades but with L1R5 \leq 15 student will be provisionally admitted but he will need to re-sit exams and must clear the relevant subjects in the following year's GCE O-Level exams.



Entry Requirements to Millennia Institute

a) at least a D7 for Mother Tongue (MT) [or a pass in CLB/MLB/TLB]
AND a Mathematics Subject

b) L1R4 \leq 20 points

- L1 - English
- R1 & R2 - Science or Math or Humanities Subject
- R3 & R4 - Any other 2 Subjects

(CCA grades can be counted as a subject)

c) Failed to obtain the requisite language and/or Math grades but with L1R4 \leq 15, student will be provisionally admitted but he will need to re-sit and must clear the relevant subjects in the following year's GCE O-Level exams.



Entry Requirements to the Polytechnics

- a) ELR2B2 \leq 26 (including CCA bonus points)

- b) EL - English
R2 - Two relevant subjects
(for most courses, usually a Math and a Science Subject)
B2 - Any other two Best subjects*

- c) No Mother Tongue requirement needed

* CCA grades cannot be counted as one of the subjects but bonus points are given for those with strong CCAs
